WHY CHOOSE DANCE?




Dance is a **fun**, **energetic and extremely successful** subject that will improve your **physical and mental wellbeing** and provide you with **invaluable life skills and experiences**.








WHAT WILL YOU LEARN?



Internally assessed unit: Exploring the Performing Arts

Investigating an example of professional performing arts work. Developing dance technique in a range of dance styles from professional work investigated. Exploring the techniques, processes and approaches used in the creation of the professional work(s).



Internally assessed unit: Developing Skills and Techniques in the Performing Arts

You will work as part of a group to learn a professional performing arts piece. As a performer, you will learn, rehearse and perform an extract from the existing piece of professional work you are studying.

Externally assessed unit: Responding to a Brief

You will work as part of a group to create your own performance in response to a given brief or stimulus. You will be responsible for creating the dance and choosing the music, props and costumes.

You will perform your final piece to an audience.



You will continue to learn and develop skills and techniques during Dance Club in the following styles:

Hip Hop
Street Dance
Commercial
Jazz
Musical Theatre
Contemporary
Afro

You will also be preparing for Dance for Film and Dance Performances.

OPPORTUNITIES

- You will perform in termly shows and projects with industry professionals.
