

# A Student from NCS (with BBD in her AS Exams) joined us in August and wanted to study Computer Science

- Naturally, I have had an interest in computers since a young age. As I grew up, my interest got more profound and I started learning new technologies on my own.
- As I would say "Computers are the most influential tools in our lives, they are our present and future".
- From my point of view in this planet nothing can really measure the exponential growth and excitement in the computer industry.
- My goals are to become a part of the team of computing and by this my main aim is to use my A level ICT as a first step to my chosen career.

### 3 Months later as part of Barking Abbey's HPP programme:

- At **a recent lecture at UCL** by Lourdes Agapito, I was introduced to the Mandelbrot Set. Mandelbrot was the first to use a computer to visualize a formalization of " $z=z^2 + c$ ", to generate an infinite set of images. What I found fascinating was how he could use such a simple formula on a computer and create the most complex identity of mathematics. This link between Maths and computing has fuelled my desire to study Computer science.
- **The Economist's article**, 'The rise of the machines' focuses on a pivotal question, "When should one draw the line between humans and Artificial Intelligence?" If AI has our intellectual ability, I believe it should be classed as a human. Perhaps this becomes a matter of philosophy rather than science.
- The **Sutton Trust coding programme** has given me an insight into 'Scratch' where I could make my own games, using drag and drop programming.
- For 2 months **'The Brilliant Club'**, gave me the opportunity to attend university style lectures where I engaged with philosophy and mathematical dilemmas exploring with PhD students from Oxford University.
- **Student also attended a Martin Ford lecture on the Rise of the Robots in late November and in January 2017 visited a big AI Debate with Professor Brian Cox at the London SouthBank Centre**
